Creating your own Aura's is easy and Aurasma walks you through the process.

\ How to create an Aura

/ Step 1

Pick your content from our library or your device.



Create >

/ Step 2

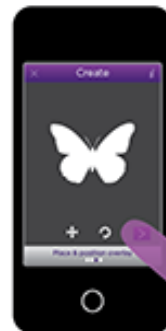
Take a clear picture of your trigger - don't press the button until the bar goes green!



Ok >

/ Step 3

Get your content into position and scale it. When you're ready, tap the arrow.



Ok >

Hit the + icon to create an Aura overlay. You will be guided through The process.

Explore our library of overlays or add one from your device

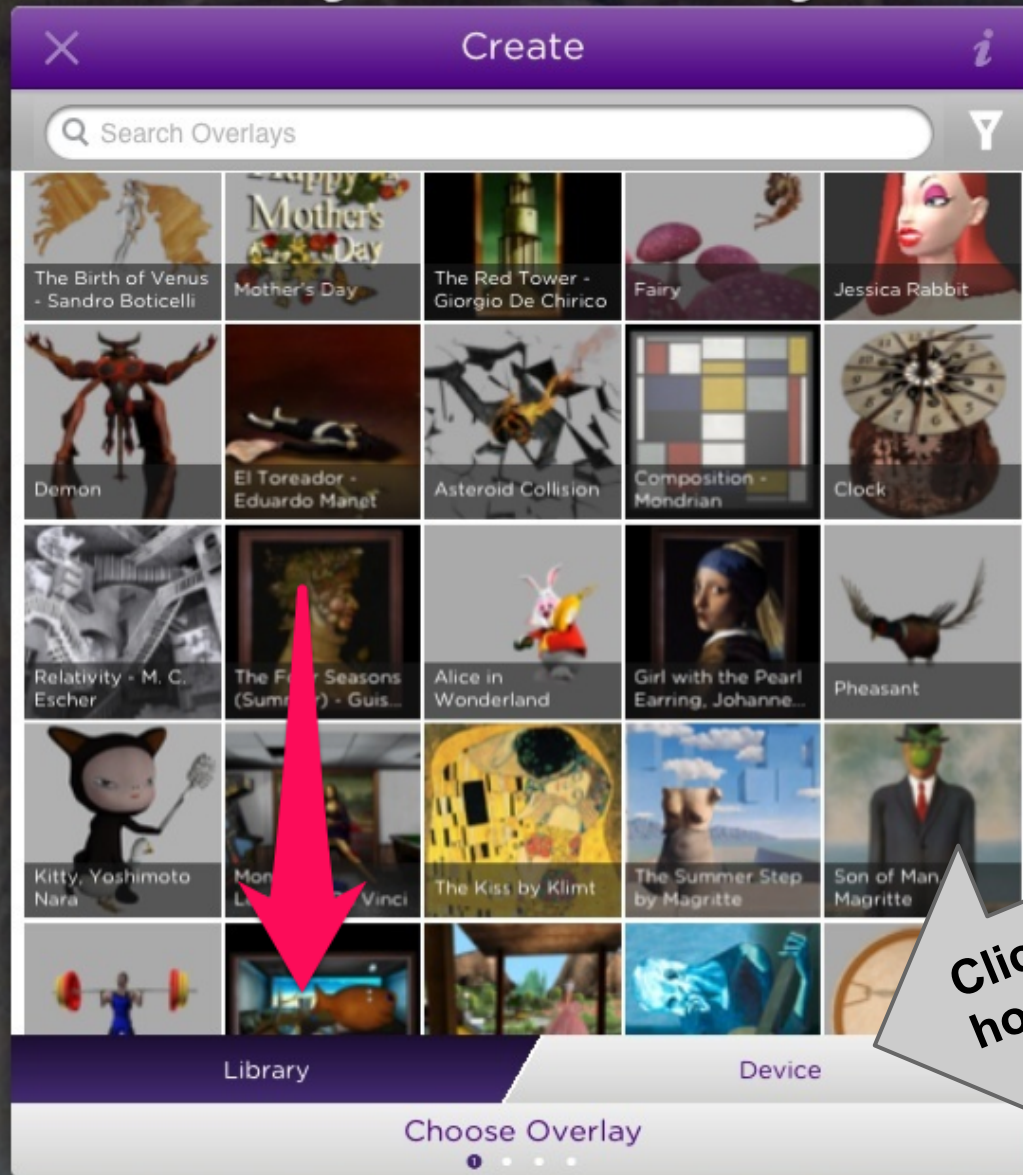
Tap images for a preview and to make your selection

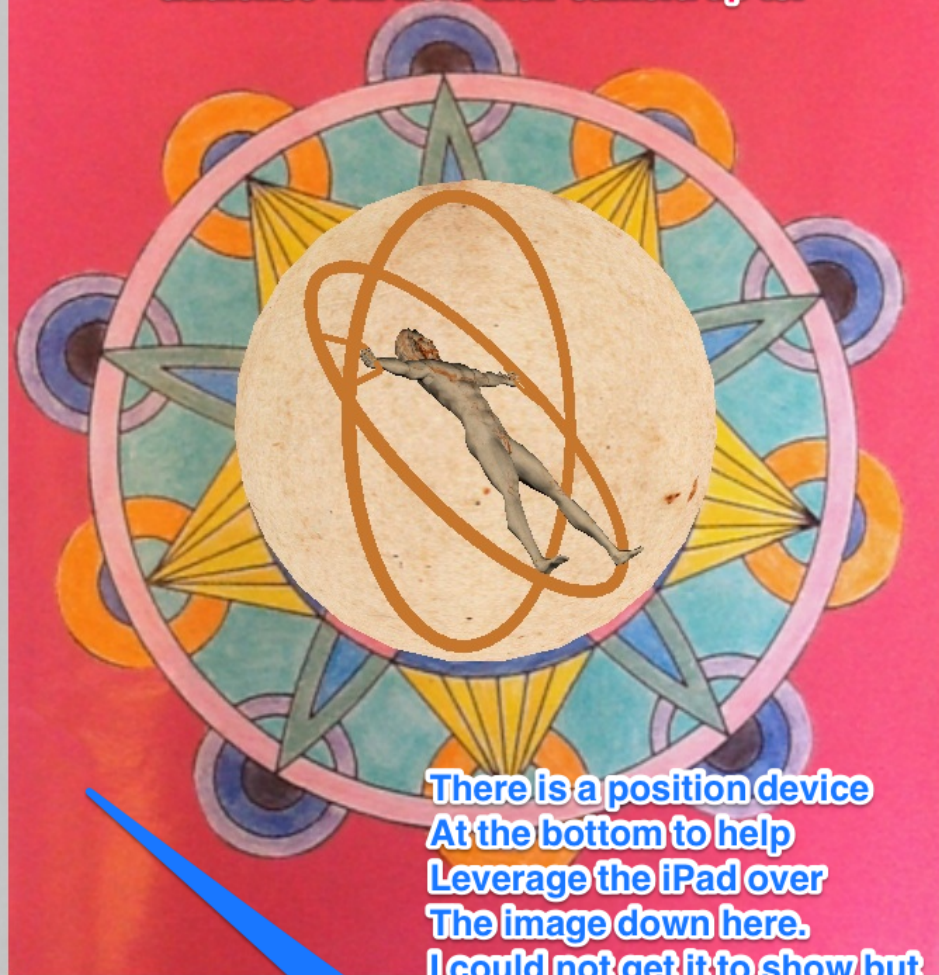

Aurasma Vocabulary

To the best of my understanding:

Triggers: The static picture you will use to set the process in motion and sit in the background.

Overlays: The videos or pictures that will be seen inserted into the triggers

Aura: an Overlay and a trigger together.
